

**Dual/Concurrent Enrollment Approved Courses  
Henderson High School and Kilgore College  
2010-11**

- To enroll in Kilgore College before graduation, students must adhere to the following guidelines:
  - Seniors 2011 – THEA exempt through TAKS, ACT, or SAT scores.
    - TAKS – English Language Arts scaled score 2200 with a writing subsection score of at least 3
    - ACT – Composite score of 23 with a minimum of 19 on the English and/or math test
    - SAT – Composite score of 1070 with a minimum of 500 on the critical reading test and/or math test
    - THEA – minimum scores of 230 on reading, 220 on writing, or 230 on math
    - ACCUPLACER – minimum standards for college level courses: Reading, 78, Writing, 6 on essay and 80 or above on Sentence Skills; Elementary Algebra, 63
  - Juniors 2011 – Students taking dual credit after their sophomore year must meet the minimum ACT, SAT, 10<sup>th</sup> grade TAKS, THEA, or ACCUPLACER scores as listed above.
- Students must come to the Counseling Center to get an Early Admission Form signed by a counselor or principal approving enrollment.
- Students should fill out an Application for Admission to Kilgore College.
- Students should go to Kilgore College and meet with the Early Admissions Counselor for registration [Jane Hanlon (903) 983-8202]. Take the Kilgore College Application, a high school transcript, and the Early Admission Request Form to the meeting with Kilgore College counselor.
