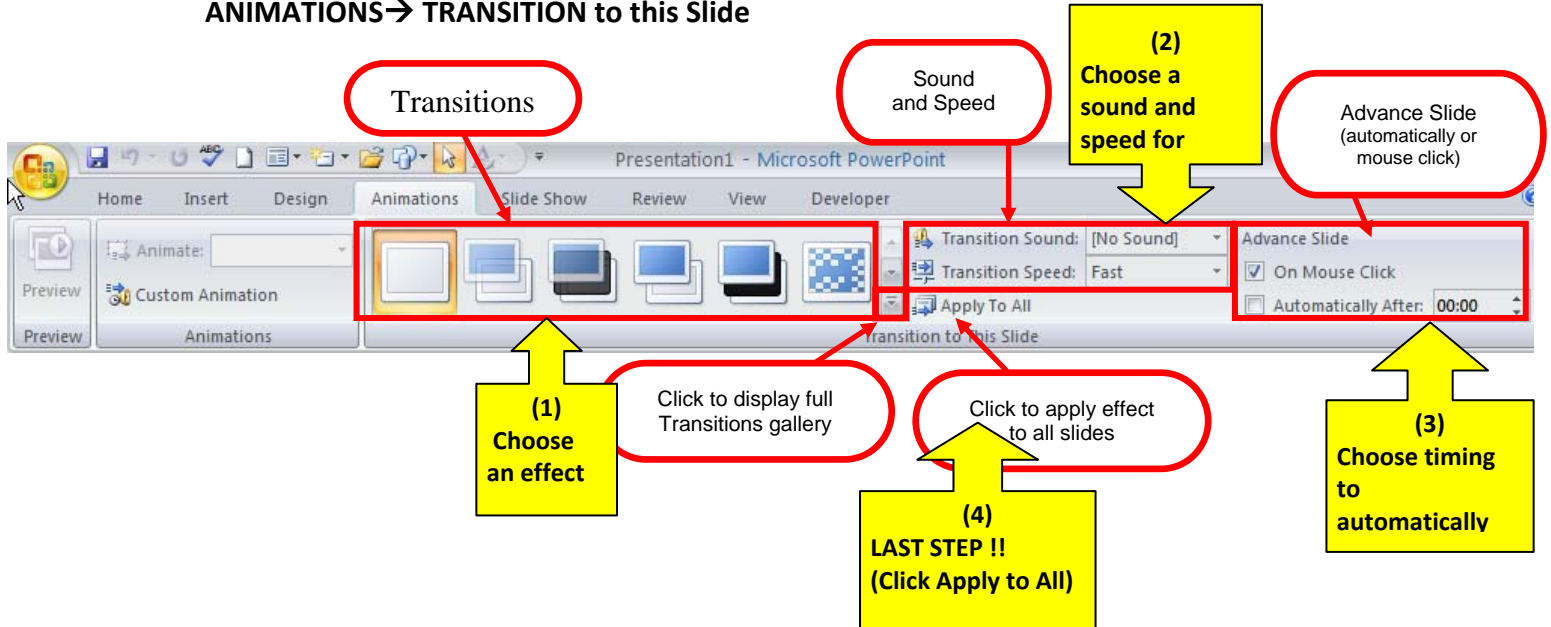


## POWERPOINT NOTES #3 - TRANSITIONS AND ANIMATIONS

### SLIDE TRANSITIONS

A slide transition is the effect as you move from one slide to the next (**ONLY THE SLIDE MOVES**). This is also how timing is set to make the slide show move or play automatically.

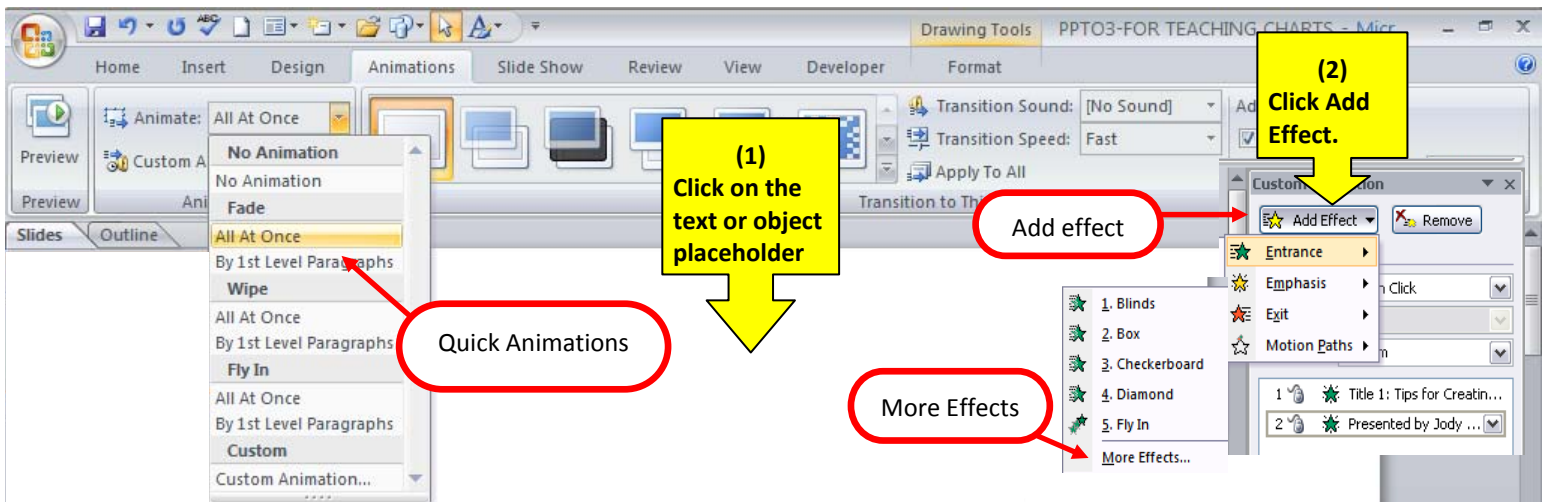
#### ANIMATIONS → TRANSITION to this Slide



### ANIMATIONS

Animations make the objects on the slide move—such as the title, bulleted items, clipart, etc. REMEMBER—too much of a good thing can be very distracting.

- Entrance**- Animation coming on to the slide.
- Emphasis**- Animation of the object at the place it is.
- Exit**- Animation leaving the slide.
- Motion Paths**- Customized path for the object to move on the slide.

This menu allows you to customize movements individually in a slide.
